Directions

Follow these steps to demonstrate conducting a whole lesson:

Before your lesson:

1. Describe how you will create a climate/milieu for effective learning, *and* tell what behaviors you want us to observe.

During your lesson:

2. Interact with learners.
3. Ask prepared developmental questions during guided practice.
4. Evaluate your *instruction* and *guided practice* phases with *closure* questions for random learners.

After your lesson:

5. Report how you feel and think about lesson's results.
6. Listen to three observers' reports about climate/milieu, process, content.
7. Get videotape record of session and its reports.
