

## Instructing by Using the Modeling Process

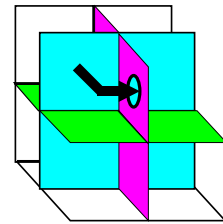
**Objective** Using the four-phase modeling process for 10 minutes, instructor-trainee instructs learners how to do a new task.

*Note:* Your course instructor will videotape only four volunteers for whole-group debriefings.

**Directions**

1. Instruct two persons in your trio, using the modeling process.
  - Focus on Instruction.
  - Follow your plan.
  - Take up to 10 minutes.
2. Allow other persons to observe in silence.
3. Be recorded on videotape, if you volunteer.
4. Listen to observers' reports after you finish.

1. Orientation
2. Persuasion
3. Instruction, Guided Practice, Closure
4. Independent Practice
5. Evaluation
